

Patch Test Instructions

- 1. Do not take antihistamines (Benadryl, atarax/hydroxyzine, Claritin or its generic versions, Clarinex, Allegra or Zyrtec) or prednisone (Cortisone) during the test period.
- 2. Leave all patches in place for 48 hours.
- 3. The patches should not get wet at any time. During this test, you must not shower but you may bathe.
- 4. Try to avoid strenuous physical activities that could make you sweat (such as aerobic exercises).
- 5. If any patches loosen during the test period, you can add additional tape, but do not replace any existing tape.
- 6. Once the patches are removed, you may shower with water but do not apply soap or scrub the test area.
- 7. Minor itching is normal under the patches. If the itching is severe, you can place a cold ice pack on the area. If there is burning, please call the office at 303-604-1444.
- 8. After the test reading, you should contact the office if additional redness develops within several days.
- 9. Copays are collected at each visit, if required by insurance.
- 10. Patch tests are normally scheduled on Monday, Wednesday and Friday. Monday - Patches are placed on the test area Wednesday- Patches are removed, and doctor will examine for any reaction(s).

Friday- Doctor will examine for any delayed reaction(s).
